Arrival Day

84 Henry Road, Goomboorian, Queensland, 4570 (which is located half way between the town of Gympie and Rainbow Beach). Arrive at our farm to meet our team and horses at 2:00pm

Andrew McCarthy will run through a riding demonstration and guests will also have the opportunity to have a short ride with the team whilst luggage is taken up to the accommodation. Guests will then be transported to the top of Mount Goomboorian, which commands stunning views all the way from Fraser Island to Noosa, and areas in between.

We will be joined for the duration of the ride by legendary Australian Country Music singer, Tania Kernaghan.

First day of riding - Pub Ride



After a leisurely start and tasty breakfast, we'll begin the riding adventure.

On the first day we ride through open grazing country, gullies and timbered country, with the chance of spotting a koala before a lunch stopover at Sublime Farm and Brewery.

At Sublime guests will enjoy a bespoke experience of having a photo taken on your horse, in the bar, enjoying a drink before we secure the horses in the beautiful gardens and enjoy some iconic Australian "pub grub".

After a relaxing lunch, we continue through open grazing country, rainforest, pine forest, and timbered country.

We ride on the same route used by the pioneers with their bullock wagons in the late 1800's and early 1900's before riding back up to Mt Goomboorian.



We will unsaddle and yard our horses before enjoying the ambience of the mountain views and surrounding landscape, a hot shower then refreshments, a cosy fire and another sumptuous meal.









Second day of riding - Homestead Ride

On this day we will immerse ourselves in the true that Australians have been refining for many decades.

The exact nature of mustering will depend upon the operational needs of the farm at the time of the ride, but it's a full day in the saddle, stopping off for lunch before returning to Mount Goomboorian for another delicious meal.



Third day of riding - Beach and Swimming ride at Rainbow Beach

We will be heading to glorious Rainbow Beach for a beach ride and then bareback swim in the ocean taking in the incredible views of Rainbow Beach and the iconic coloured sands.

We ride along Rainbow Beach in saddles, then whilst on the beach, our team will unsaddle the horses, layer down to our swimming gear and ride bareback into the ocean (for those who wish to).

After our swim in the ocean, we ride bareback back to the yards, where we enjoy fish and chips on the grassy flats beside our stables. There will be some free time in the afternoon to explore Rainbow Beach and the beautiful surrounding areas.





Fourth day of riding - Cattle work

On the last two days, guests receive education, guidance and practice on how to work and control cattle from horseback.

The skills required to control and communicate effectively with your horse, and control and guide cattle whilst maintaining cattle welfare, with the ultimate aim being to implement the same skills utilised daily by stockmen & women throughout Australia's pastoral industry.



Final day of riding and departure

Our final day will continue working with cattle in the morning, lunch together at Fraser Grill before saying our fond farewells
